



The Information Assurance Center is co-hosting a seminar, "Protecting Yourself Against Identity Theft," with Delaware Technical & Community College. Identity theft is a nationwide epidemic and you will learn what you can do to help protect yourself.



As more people use the Internet for personal transactions, it is important to adopt operations security (OPSEC) procedures and practices to protect oneself from identity theft. Rick Estberg of the Department of Defense (DoD) will discuss identity theft and how individuals can apply the military's OPSEC procedures in their everyday lives.
