Track	Description
	<p>For two consecutive years, Wilmington University has won first place in the undergraduate category of the international DC3 Digital Forensics Challenge competition. Building upon our expertise in computer forensics and the popularity of TV shows like CSI and NCIS, the participants in this track will learn the computer forensic analysis techniques to solve a fictional crime.</p>
	<p>Storyboarding is a common systems design technique. In the “<i>You Tell IT, Girl!</i>” track, the participants will learn design concepts to create a website to tell their own interactive story.</p>
	<p>Gaming is becoming integrated into how we learn, socialize, interact, and gather information. In this track, the participants will learn how to design and develop their own computer games.</p>
	<p>In this track, participants will learn computer-based technologies to enable them to create and edit their own short, digital films. We will promote the results on the Wilmington University social networking webpages.</p>
	<p>The field of computer-based graphic design has seen a recent explosion of career opportunities, from education to business to entertainment. This track will introduce computer-based design technologies so participants can produce their own multimedia design.</p>
